



Pumpkin Patch Block of the Month

Handed out in October for Return in November

You will need white on Beige for Background Fabric. You will need a green, light medium or dark for the stem. I cut two blocks of each orange and orange/red that I had, I threw in two yellow but I would not use a lot of yellow. I lacked choices in oranges. I used about 10 different orange/reds

Cutting Instructions: Cut five backgrounds $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares, Cut one Background 3 " square, Cut one background rectangle $3'x 5\frac{1}{2}'$

Choose a green $3\frac{3}{8}$ " square and layer it with your background square and sew half square triangle to get two.

Choose four $3\frac{3}{8}$ " orange to layered with $3\frac{3}{8}$ " background squares to sew half square techniques.

Cut out Sixteen 3 " squares of oranges/orange reds (and maybe a bit yellow.

Sewing Instructions: I sewed all my half/square triangles first. You will have to many as 4 backgrounds layered with a orange square gives you 8 half/squares. You can throw away the extra or make two blocks. I then sewed the rows in order , chain pieces two blocks together as often as I could and then sewing the rows together. I pressed and spray with steam press as I went. You do have some seams to match. I used butted seams(top one lays towards you in sewing and bottom seam lays away from you. Pin and match the seams before you sew the row.) I thought this might make a nice wall hanging in order of the Fall season.
