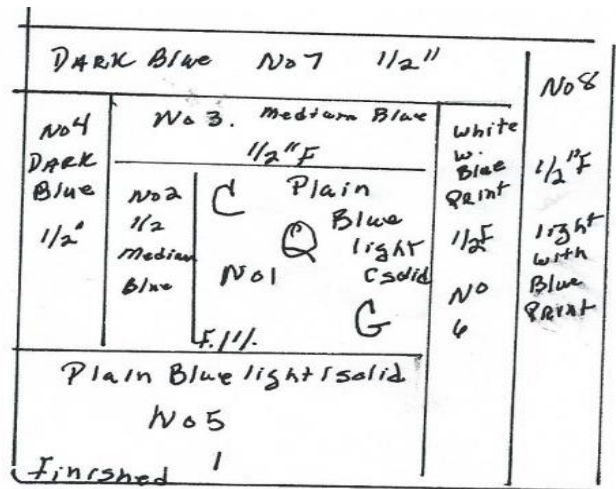


## Chilliwack Quilters' Guild Badge



### Name Tag

1. light Blue solid 2" square
2. light blue print 2" x 1"
3. light blue print 2 1/2" x 1"
4. dark blue print 2" x 1"
5. Solid light blue 3" 1 1/2"
6. light print 3 1/2" x 1"
7. Dark Blue Print
8. White with blue print.
  - This does not sew like a regular log cabin but goes left to top and then repeats again on the left side. Just follow the colors on the visual
  - All logs except center and No. 1 are cut at 1" strips to give you 1/2" finished seams.
  - Because it is small, it is better that you work in cottons rather than perm a press as it stretches.
  - One and five must be solids you can embroidery or write with a pigma pen CQG and your name on . CQG angles from top left to bottom right on center square.
  - You need a 4 1/2" back and batting.
  - It is better to do the quilting before you put on the binding
  - You will need a stripe of solid or print ,if you choose, I cut 2 1/2" x 23" and folded in over to make a double binding. I mitered the corners but that's a choice.
  - It does not work to do pillow slip method as it makes it too small.
  - You need to quilt it by hand or machine and you can put a hanger, using ribbon or whatever you choose so it will hand from your neck or sew a pin on the back.
  - *It should be 4 1/2" square when finished.*
